Flight Lesson 5, Page 39: Under "Completion Standards," the following text was edited to comply with 14 CFR Part 61.93(e)(12). This section was previously edited in our August 2014 update.

Completion Standards

The lesson will have been successfully completed when the student displays an understanding of the procedures to be used during various emergency operations and is able to make a normal landing with instructor assistance demonstrates the proper entry procedures and understands how to maintain a specific ground track during the performance of ground reference maneuvers. Additionally, the student will demonstrate improved increased proficiency in maneuvering during slow flight and improved recognition of and recovery from stalls emergency procedures. The student should be able to maintain desired altitude, ±200 ft.; airspeed, ±15 kt.; and heading, ±20° during straight and level flight. Additionally, the student will display an understanding of the basic instrument maneuvers.
