The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is pleased to notify you that we have accepted your 20-1 hour on-line Study Unit courses titled, “**AMT/IA-Online Training**” that you submitted for Inspection Authorization (IA) refresher training.

As of this date, the material submitted meets the requirements of Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR) part 65, § 65.93(a) (4), for IA renewal.

Your course will remain on the FAA’s active list of accepted IA renewal courses for 24 calendar-months unless suspended or removed for cause.

Training must reflect the actual hours of training whether the entire course is completed by attendee or selected study units of this course.
